





 - **Brownwood Paddock Square:** With the look of an early 19th century Florida cattle town, Brownwood Paddock square features a log cabin stage with stadium seating for outdoor entertainment. Enjoy the selection of restaurants and shop the farmers’ market every Saturday.
 - **Spanish Springs Town Square:** Home to the Sharon L. Morse Performing Arts Center, Spanish Springs is your destination for Broadway quality entertainment and live concerts. Relax by the picturesque fountains in the Square or dance to live music each evening.
 - **Dragon Flower Winery:** Quaint and authentic, this winery features handcrafted wines and local beers in a relaxed atmosphere.

TO SEE:

- **Scenic Sumter Heritage Byway:** Winding through several old Florida roadways and friendly communities, the Scenic Sumter Heritage Byway features pastoral farmlands and beautiful Lake Panasoffkee.
 - **Sharon Rose Wiechens Preserve:** Dozens of animals and amphibians can be found on this 625-acre wetland. Make sure to bring binoculars and a camera to make the most out of the observation deck!
 - **Florida National Cemetery:** Located in the Withlacoochee State Forest, the Florida National Cemetery has a variety of memorials to honor America's veterans along its Memorial Pathway.
 - **Lake Okahumpka Park:** At 130 acres, Lake Okahumpka Park includes bike trails, a 9-hole frisbee golf course, and a 2-lane boat ramp. Enjoy a series of exercise stations or walk your pup along clearly marked trails.
 - **Back Road Berries:** Stroll fields of strawberries, blueberries, and blackberries. Call ahead to pick your own or stop by and pickup homemade pies and cobblers made from fresh, seasonal berries.
